# Marin Civil Grand Jury – Responses to Recommendations

#### Recommendation #1

By December 1,2023, the Board of Directors should initiate a fully transparent, public process to be completed by April 1, 2024, that examines how SMART might continue funding its operations beyond April 2029, including evaluation of when the voters would decide whether to continue levying a sales Tax for SMART's operations.

 SMART staff said it would prepare a financial analysis beyond April 2029 for presentation at the September Board meeting.



### **Scenarios**

#### Base Plan

- Sales/ Use tax extended prior to FY 29
- Service levels continue as planned
- Reserves continue to grow for capital replacement
- Match is available for future grants



### **Scenarios**

#### Scenario #1:

- Sales/Use Tax is not extended prior to FY 29
- Service levels continue as planned through FY 29
- Service levels are reduced slightly (7%) in FY 30 until funds run out
- No funds available for dissolution of SMART if doesn't pass a sales/use tax extension in FY 30
- Only reserve is OPEB/Pension which can't be used for dissolution



#### **Scenarios**

#### Scenario #2:

- Sales/Use Tax is <u>not</u> extended prior to FY 29
- Service levels continue as planned through FY 28
- Service levels are reduced by 50% in FY 29 and 30
- Leaves some reserves if sales/use tax is extended in FY 30
- Leaves funds for disposition in FY 31 if extension is not successful in FY 30
