# Agenda Item 9 - Implementation and Maintenance of Riparian Enhancement in Helen Putman Regional Park



### **Overview**

 Required Mitigation: McInnis Pkway to Smith Ranch Rd pathway construction

- Riparian Mitigation: planting of native trees to replace riparian vegetation that was impacted as part of constructing the project
- Helen Putnam Park in Petaluma: same watershed as the McInnis non-Motorized pathway.

### Helen Putnam Regional Park

#### **Two Locations:**

### **Windsor Drive Drainage:**

An erroded channel with sparse riparian vegetation, carrying seasonal drainage to a culvert beneath Windsor Drive.

### **Upper Pond Drainage:**

Freshwater stream that supports intermittent flow and drains into Cattail Pond which is publicly accessible fishing pond.


